Chamba is a beautiful natural hamlet situated across the junction of roads from Mussoorie and Rishikesh. Located just 5 hours drive from NCR, it is tucked in the beautiful region of Tehri Garhwal, settled amidst the Himalayas. In next 1 year, it is expected that the commute time will reduce to 3.5 hrs b/w NCR and Chamba. The region is home to a serene environment and enchanting weather. A gateway to Himalayan natural beauty comprising lush greeneries, spell-binding valleys, hills, and mountain peaks, the region is a perfect recipe for wellness and rejuvenation.

A relatively less explored region, when compared to other popular destinations in Uttarakhand such as Dehradun, Rishikesh, Manali, etc., the Chamba (part of the wider Tehri Garhwal) encompasses in itself nature's bewilderment. There are beautiful natural water bodies that add to the overall scenic beauty. There is the Bhagirathi River as well as the Tehri Dam, India's highest man-made dam. The Tehri dam spread across a vast 52 Sq Km is a complete tourist ecosystem in itself.

The region is also well-placed with multiple other popular tourist destinations such as

Uttarkashi, Rudraprayag, Rishikesh, Haridwar, Narendra Nagar, etc.

An underground tunnel has been proposed to connect Dehradun with Tehri Lake. The alignment report for the mega project is presently under preparation. The project named Tehri Tunnel will be the largest underground tunnel project in the world. Post completion, the project will reduce the travel time between Dehradun and Chamba to ~ 40 mins from 2 hours currently.

As interest in Chamba is picking up, the property market in the scenic region is also set for an upswing. Presently property prices are rising at a moderate rate of 3% but can soon accelerate, given the interest on Chamba is soaring. The region is a fertile ground for gated projects, serviced living, second homes, retirement villas, homestays, etc. Similarly, there is also huge potential for hotels, resorts, staycation, rejuvenation hotels, adventure sports, farm stays, etc.

Introduction A

There is a newfound interest in Chamba located around 70 kms from Rishikesh in the Tehri Garhwal district. Chamba is located at the intersection of the roads emanating from Mussoorie and Rishikesh. Located in a background of snowcapped mountains and situated at a height of 3500

feet, Chamba is a relatively unexplored territory, which further renews interest in the region. It is a relatively cold region with the temperature hovering at -2- 20 degrees Celsius. However, these days during summer, the temperature can go up to 25 degree Celsius.



The iconic Tehri dam is located in the region, which is one of the largest lakes in India spread across an area of 52 Sq Km. It is also home to one of the biggest hydropower projects in India. 








The Tehri Tunnel Project: Key Information



Key facts about the tunnel

- The proposed tunnel (35 kms) will directly connect the Dehradun city with the Tehri Lake.
- Presently it takes 105 km to reach Tehri from Mussoorie via Dehradun which involves NH-7 and NH-34. Post the completion of the tunnel, the commute will reduce to less than an hour.
- It will start from Rajpur in Dehradun and end at Koti Colony near Tehri lake.
- The total distance will be 35 kms, out of which the main tunnel will be \sim 27 kms and the rest will be road
- This will be the largest tunnel in the world. The current biggest tunnel is in Norway, at Laedral (24.5 kms)
- It will be a two double-lane tunnel with designated U-turns to commute b/w the two.
 The two tunnels have been proposed keeping safety in mind. However, the final design will be subject to the feasibility study and DPR.
- The project will boost tourism and real estate in the Tehri region.
