India's Organized Farmstay Sector

This is driving demand for farmstays, farmhouses and farm plots, both in verdant urban peripheries and traditional scenic destinations.

In a time, when major Indian cities are marred with hectic lifestyle, noise & traffic and growing stress levels, residents are opting for opportunities to take regular breaks and recharge their physical and mental batteries. A farmstay in a serene and verdant landscape is a perfect escape from the complexities of modern day urban life. It offers a very imbibing, slow paced and mindfulness driven lifestyle to the discerning vacationers.

Interestingly, not just tourists but many homeowners are now either permanently shifting to managed farmhouses or using them for long stays. A spurt in flexible working culture further makes it possible to many homebuyers to permanently/ semi-permanently shift into managed farmhouses and stay close to nature & rural lifestyle that can ensure overall mental and physical wellbeing.

Consequently, this is driving demand for curated farmstays across the length and breadth, from lush green off-city limits to coast lines to hidden hamlets in the hilly terrains. The concept is becoming popular across India.

As per the latest study by Axon Developers, the size of the organized and branded farmstay market is close to ~Inr 16,100 crores. What is more interesting is the fact that the market is growing at a CAGR of around ~ 41% and is slated to reach Inr 64, 250 crores by 2029. Area wise, around half of the market is concentrated in the southern parts of the country, with Hyderabad and Bangalore (especially Nandi Hills area) emerging as pioneers. Around 29% of the market is located in western parts of India with Alibaug, Sindhudurg, Mulshi, Tilari, Lonavala, leading the bandwagon.

There are presently around ~ 17,700 farmstay units spanning over 150+ projects all over the country. As per our research, the aggregate volume of farmstay units in the organized space is set to cross 46,000 units in next 4 years, further underlining the scorching speed with which organized farmstay is picking up pace.

In the near future, organized farmstay will continue thrive and don a pioneering role in India's experiential real estate market alongside second homes, vacation villas and branded homes, etc. This will also unlock business avenues for new developers, villa management start-ups, organic farm management enterprises, landscape designer, sustainability consultants and much more.

Accessibility can be a challenge in many farmstays as they might be located in a remote/ off-site location with limited roads & infrastructure.

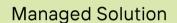

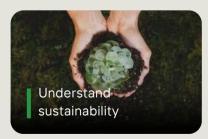






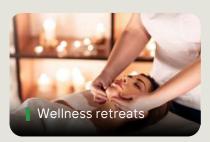

Current Acreage

Currently, 11, 140 acres of land are dedicated to organized farmstay sector in India.





Projected Acreage

By 2029, the total area of organized farmstay is set to reach 37,000 acres, growing at a CAGR of \sim 35%.



Unit Growth

Currently there are close to 18,700 units in 2025. Over the course of next 4 years, the total organized farmstay units are set to cross 46,000 units.

Market Value

The total size of the market is around Inr 16,100 crores. By 2029, the market is set to reach Inr 63,250 crores, growing at a CAGR 40.8%.





Southern Dominance

Half of the organized farmstay market is situated in the southern parts of India. Major farmstay destinations in Southern India include Nandi hills, Hyderabad, Coorg, etc.





Western Share

29% of the organized farmstay market (area) is situated in western parts of India. Major market locations in west include, Sindhudurg, Karajat, Alibaug, Tilari, Mulshi, Lonavala, etc.





Northern & Eastern Market

The remaining market is dominated by North and East, with the former contributing the major portion.





Emerging North

Emerging destinations in the North are Dehradun, Pant Nagar, NH-8, Naugaon, Alwar, etc.

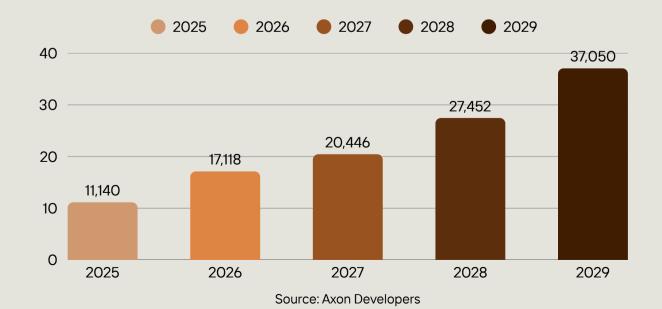




Unit Contribution

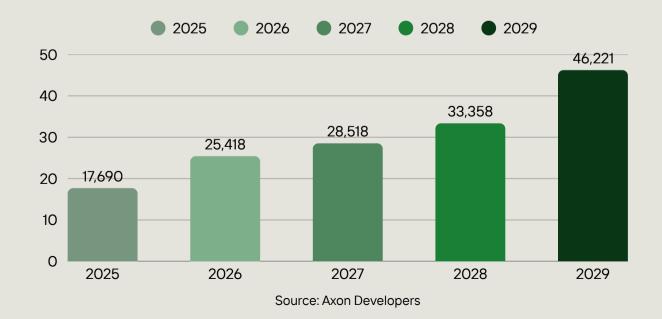
In terms of unit-wise break-up, both west and south have near equal contribution with 38 and 40% respectively.

Growth of organized farm stay market in India (Acres)

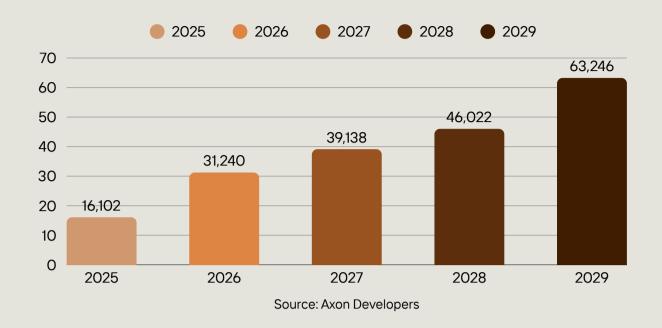




Growth of organized farmstay market in India (Units)

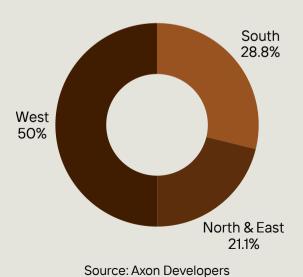


Growth of organized farmstay market in India (Inr Crores)





Region-wise break-up of organized farmstay market share (area)



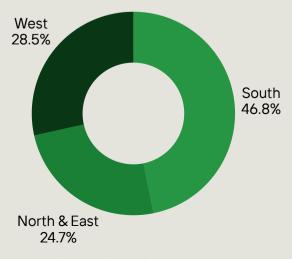
Region wise break-up of organized farmstay market share (total units)
